The Nurse Educator concentration requires a minimum of **39** credit hours. **Hybrid-virtual synchronous** learning requires all course participants to be face-2-face at the same time on a virtual platform on designated dates and also includes an **asynchronous** online learning component. **Asynchronous** learning is online at any time.

6944L the advanced teaching practicum is spread over 3 credits and taken in different semesters. Each experience will concentrate on either classroom/didactic, online or clinical/practice lab/simulation experiences. The classroom/clinical/simulation experiences are live and require face-2-face interaction. **6711** has **2 virtual** Saturdays and **1 live** weekend. **6006** is **Hybrid** and has **5 virtual synchronous** sessions.
