Suggested Online Course Sequence

This document is intended to serve as a planning resource for students in developing your [“Plan of Study”](#) in consultation with your academic advisor. It provides you with information as to which courses are offered online in which semester, and the sequence in which courses should be taken.

Students may begin the program in either the Fall or Spring semester; we have provided Suggested Course Sequences below to accommodate either option.

Since many of our online students are working professionals, and would prefer to complete the degree on a part-time basis, since the full time plan is a rigorous schedule, we have provided 2 suggested sequences – one full time and one part-time.
