“Robota” : **Forced labor**

“Robota” was first used in the Czech play Rossum’s Universal Robots[1].

“Robots” originally existed **in imaginary worlds**.

What Are Robots?

International Organization for Standardization (ISO) defines robots as the following:

(ISO8373)

Actuated mechanism programmable in two or more axes with a degree of autonomy, moving within its environment, to perform intended tasks[4].

This definition may change over time.
